Standard Operating Permit Condition VI – Good Air Pollution Control Practices

Emissions [EMISSION] Unit Categories This Condition Applies to: All emissions [EMISSION] units that are not insignificant or that use a control device, except that Standard Operating Permit Condition (SPC) [STANDARD PERMIT CONDITION] VI does not apply

- 1. to any **emissions** [EMISSION] unit subject to an emission standard in 40 C.F.R. 60, 40 C.F.R. 61, or 40 C.F.R. 63; or
- 2. if, for each emissions standard that applies, there is continuous emissions monitoring or the permit writer finds that continuous parametric monitoring or frequency of other periodic monitoring is sufficient that equipment performance affecting emissions will not deteriorate between monitoring events.

The <u>Department</u> [DEPARTMENT] will use <u>(SPC)</u> [STANDARD PERMIT CONDITION] VI in any operating permit unless the <u>Department</u> [DEPARTMENT] determines that <u>emissions</u> [EMISSION] unit<u>-</u> or stationary source<u>-</u>specific conditions more adequately meet the requirements of 18 AAC 50.

The following applies to this standard permit condition:

List the following in Condition 1.1:

- 1. all emissions units that have a control device; and
- 2. <u>for emission units without a control device, only those emissions units that are not insignificant under 18 AAC 50.326(e) (i).</u>

Permit Wording:

- 1. Good Air Pollution Control Practice.
 - 1.1 <u>Except as noted in Condition 1.d, the [THE] Permittee [PERMITTEE] shall do the following for EU IDs [EMISSION UNITS] < identify emissions [EMISSION] units>:</u>
 - a. perform regular maintenance considering the manufacturer's or the operator's maintenance procedures;
 - b. keep records of any maintenance that would have a significant effect on emissions; the records may be kept in electronic format; **and**
 - c. keep a copy of either the manufacturer's or the operator's maintenance procedures.
 - d. <u>EU ID(s) <identify EUs that will change status></u> are subject to this condition only until the applicable compliance date as set forth in Conditions <*cross-reference condition(s)* for EUs that state

<u>compliance</u> due date(s), such as NSPS/NESHAP affected EUs that have a compliance date in the middle of the permit term>.

[THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO THIS STANDARD PERMIT CONDITION:

- 1. CONDITION VI.1.1 WILL
 - LIST ALL EMISSION UNITS WITH A CONTROL DEVICE; AND
 - FOR EMISSION UNITS WITHOUT A CONTROL DEVICE, LIST ONLY THOSE EMISSION UNITS
 - THAT ARE NOT INSIGNIFICANT UNDER 18 AAC 50.326(d) (i).]
