Standard Operating Permit Condition VIII –Visible Emissions and Particulate Matter Monitoring Plan for Gas[-FIRED] Fuel<u>-</u>Burning Equipment

<u>Emissions</u> [EMISSION] Unit or Stationary Source Categories This Condition Applies to: Gas[- FIRED] fuel-burning equipment subject to the opacity standard of 18 AAC 50.055(a)(1), except flares.

The <u>Department</u> [DEPARTMENT] will use <u>Standard Operating Permit Condition (SPC)</u> [STANDARD PERMIT CONDITION] VIII in any operating permit unless the <u>Department</u> [DEPARTMENT] determines that emission unit<u>-</u> or stationary source<u>-</u>specific conditions more adequately meet the requirements of 18 AAC 50.

Circumstances where emission unit or stationary source specific conditions more adequately meet 18 AAC 50 include:

1. if the **Department** [DEPARTMENT] finds that equipment may not adequately eliminate entrained liquid **from the gas fuel**.

Permit Wording:

 Industrial Process and Fuel-Burning Equipment Visible Emissions. The <u>Permittee</u> [PERMITTEE] shall not cause or allow visible emissions, excluding condensed water vapor, emitted from <u>EU(s)</u> < <u>insert EU numbers</u> [IDENTIFY EMISSION UNITS]> <u>listed in</u> <u>Table < insert Table of Emissions Unit Inventory ></u> to reduce visibility through the exhaust effluent by more than 20 percent averaged over any six consecutive minutes.

1.1 Monitoring, <u>Recordkeeping</u> [RECORD KEEPING], and Reporting. <u>For EU(s)</u> <<u>insert EU numbers of gas fuel-burning equipment> burn only gas as fuel.</u> Monitoring for these emissions units shall consist of a statement in each operating report under Condition <<u>insert cross reference to SPC VII - Operating Reports></u> indicating whether each of these emissions units burned only gas during the period covered by the report. Report under Condition <<u>insert cross reference to</u> <u>SPC III - Excess Emissions and Permit Deviation Reports></u> if any fuel other than gas is burned.

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a. THE PERMITTEE SHALL USE ONLY GAS AS FUEL IN EMISSION UNITS <EMISSION UNIT CITATIONS>. THE PERMITTEE SHALL CERTIFY IN EACH OPERATING REPORT REQUIRED UNDER

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CONDITION <INSERT CROSS REFERENCE TO STANDARD PERMIT CONDITION VII - OPERATING REPORTS> THAT THE EMISSION UNIT BURNED ONLY GAS.

- b. THE PERMITTEE SHALL REPORT UNDER CONDITION <INSERT CROSS REFERENCE TO STANDARD PERMIT CONDITION III - EXCESS EMISSIONS AND PERMIT DEVIATION REPORTS> IF ANY FUEL IS BURNED OTHER THAN GAS.]
- 2. <u>Industrial Process and Fuel-Burning Equipment</u> Particulate Matter Emissions. [IN ACCORDANCE WITH 18 AAC 50.055(B)(1), THE] <u>The Permittee</u> [PERMITTEE] shall not cause or allow particulate matter emitted from <u>EU(s)</u> <<u>insert EU numbers of gas fuel-burning equipment</u> [IDENTIFY EMISSION UNITS]> <u>listed in Table <insert reference to</u> <u>Table of Emissions Unit Inventory></u> to exceed 0.05 grains per cubic foot of exhaust gas corrected to standard conditions and averaged over three hours.
