### **Standard Operating Permit Condition XIV – Document Submittals and Electronic Copies**

Emission Unit or Stationary Source Categories This Condition Applies to: <u>All</u> sources and Permittees subject to 18 AAC 50.326(a)-(c).

• CONDITION XIV.1 APPLIES TO ALL SOURCES AND PERMITTEES SUBJECT TO 18 AAC 50.326(a)-(c).]

The **Department** [DEPARTMENT] will use **Standard Operating Permit Condition** (SPC) [STANDARD PERMIT CONDITION] XIV in any operating permit unless the **Department** [DEPARTMENT] determines that **emissions** [EMISSION] unit- or stationary source-specific conditions more adequately meet the requirements of 18 AAC 50.

- 1. <u>Permit Applications and Submittals.</u> The Permittee shall comply with the following requirements for submitting application information to the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA):
  - 1.1 The <u>Permittee</u> [PERMITTEE] shall provide a copy of each application for modification or renewal of this permit, including any compliance plan, or application addenda, at the time the application or addendum is submitted to the <u>Department</u> [DEPARTMENT];
  - 1.2 The information shall be submitted to the <u>Part 70 Operating Permit</u> <u>Program, US EPA Region 10, Mail Stop: OAW-150, 1200 Sixth Avenue,</u> <u>Suite 900, Seattle, WA 98101</u> [SAME ADDRESS AS IN CONDITION <INSERT REFERENCE TO ANNUAL COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATION CONDITION SUBPARAGRAPH WITH EPA'S ADDRESS>];
  - 1.3 To the extent practicable, the <u>Permittee</u> [PERMITTEE] shall provide to EPA applications in portable document format (pdf)<sub>3</sub>[;] MS Word format (.doc)<sub>.3</sub>[;] or other computer- readable format compatible with EPA's national database management system; and
  - 1.4 The <u>**Permittee**</u> [PERMITTEE] shall maintain records as necessary to demonstrate compliance with this condition.
