4 WHEREAS, the Clean Air Act requires an update to the carbon monoxide
5 maintenance plan for Anchorage to address the second half of the 20-year
6 planning period that began in July 2004; and

8 WHEREAS, the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS)
9 staff has prepared a Carbon Monoxide (CO) Limited Maintenance Plan which will
10 fulfill that requirement and will simplify future Anchorage air quality conformity
11 determinations by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency; and

13 WHEREAS, the AMATS Policy Committee recommended approval of the
14 Anchorage CO Limited Maintenance Plan during their meeting on December 20,
15 2012; now, therefore,

17 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

19 **Section 1.** That Anchorage CO Limited Maintenance Plan be approved and
20 forwarded to the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation for inclusion
21 in the State Implementation Plan for air quality and for approval by the
22 Environmental Protection Agency.

24 **Section 2.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage
25 and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

3 **Subject:** A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE
4 ADOPTING THE ANCHORAGE CARBON MONOXIDE LIMITED MAINTENANCE
5 PLAN.

7 The Clean Air Act requires an update of the carbon monoxide maintenance plan
8 for Anchorage to address the second half (July 2014 - July 2024) of the twenty
9 year maintenance period that began in July 2004. Anchorage Metropolitan Area
10 Transportation Solutions (AMATS) staff has prepared a Carbon Monoxide (CO)
11 Limited Maintenance Plan which will fulfill that requirement. Once approved by
12 the Environmental Protection Agency, this CO Limited Maintenance Plan will
13 revise the existing CO Maintenance Plan within the State Implementation Plan.
14 The revised plan will simplify the air quality conformity process by eliminating the
15 need to repeat CO emissions modeling with each update of the Anchorage
16 transportation plan.

18 THE ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS THE APPROVAL OF THE ATTACHED
19 RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ADOPTING THE
20 ANCHORAGE CARBON MONOXIDE LIMITED MAINTENANCE PLAN.



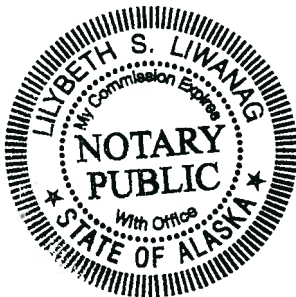

9 A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE FAIRBANKS NORTH STAR BOROUGH AIR
10 QUALITY CONTROL LIMITED MAINTENANCE PLAN

13 WHEREAS, the Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB) has not had a
14 violation of the National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) for Carbon Monoxide
15 since November 19, 1999 and has therefore been in Attainment since November 20,
16 1999; and
17

18 WHEREAS, the second 10-year plan is now required by Federal
19 requirements and it is possible to model continued attainment through 2025; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the FNSB qualifies for a Limited Maintenance Plan that
22 removes the need for an emission budget and therefore streamlines conformity; and
23

24 WHEREAS, this Air Quality Control Limited Maintenance Plan, once
25 approved by the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) and the
26 EPA, will allow conformity for current and future DOT projects; and


28 WHEREAS, since February, 2000, the Borough has not forecasted a
29 Stage 1 Alert (CO concentrations of nine parts per million) more than three times per
30 year; and

32 WHEREAS, On December 18, 2012 the Fairbanks Metropolitan Area
33 Transportation System (FMATS) Policy Committee approved the Air Quality Control
34 plan as drafted.

36 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly approves and
37 adopts the Fairbanks North Star Borough Air Quality Control Limited Maintenance Plan
38 for submission to the DEC and the EPA.


