Through this grant, DEC can provide assessment services to communities across the state, including ASTM Phase I and II environmental site assessments (ESAs), hazardous building materials (HBM) surveys, and cleanup planning.

DEC will work with you to determine whether the project is eligible and within the grant's scope and our capacity to assist.
