City of Palmer receives \$500,000 fully forgiven loan to plan for the rehabilitation and improvement of the headworks building

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) awarded a \$500,000 loan with 100% loan forgiveness to the City of Palmer for planning and design of needed improvements for the wastewater headworks building. This fully subsidized loan offers the City a valuable opportunity to plan and design a needed improvement to safely treat wastewater.

ADEC is authorized by state law to issue loans to borrowers for eligible water system infrastructure projects. Administration of the loan is through the ADEC State Revolving Fund Program under the authority of the Alaska Clean Water Fund.

The Alaska Clean Water Fund is capitalized annually by a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency. The Clean Water State Revolving Fund programs operate around the country to provide states and communities with the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources nationwide.
