ADEC awards \$550,000 fully subsidized loan to Haines Borough to design upgrades to the Haines Sewage Treatment Plant.

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) awarded a \$550,000 loan with 100% loan forgiveness to Haines Borough to design upgrades and changes to the Haines Sewage Treatment Plant to meet new Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) discharge permit requirements including the addition of disinfection.

ADEC is authorized by state law to issue loans to borrowers for eligible water system infrastructure projects. Administration of the loan is through the ADEC State Revolving Fund Program under the authority of the Alaska Clean Water Fund.

The loan from the Alaska Clean Water Fund for this project carries a below-market finance rate of 0.5%. The Alaska Clean Fund is capitalized annually by a grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The Clean Water State Revolving Fund programs nationwide provide states and communities with the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources nationwide.
