URGENT: Claim Pets by Dec. 15

Office of the State Veterinarian

The Office of the State Veterinarian and partners have successfully reunited approximately 125 dogs with their families following Typhoon Halong. However, nearly **20 dogs remain unclaimed**, and time is running out.

The Deadline is December 15, 2025 If you or someone you know is missing a pet from the storm, you must take action before this date. After December 15, unclaimed dogs will be spayed or neutered and made available for adoption to new owners.

Two Actions You Must Take:

- Check for Missing Dogs: View photos of unclaimed dogs immediately at
 AlaskaTyphoonDogs.org. If you see your dog, or are missing a dog not listed, call the Pet
 Help Hotline at 907-615-8904.
- 2. **Update Foster Information:** If you know your dog is safe in long-term foster care, you **must** check in by Dec. 15 to verify your contact info and confirm you still want to keep the dog. Call **Anchorage Animal Care and Control at 907-343-8138**.
