DONLIN GOLD PROJECT

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) has made a preliminary decision to approve Donlin Gold, LLC's (Donlin's) application for Air Quality Control Construction Permit AQ0934CPT01 for the Donlin Gold Project.

Applicant: Donlin Gold, LLC, 2525 C St., Suite 450, Anchorage, AK 99503

Location: 280 miles west of Anchorage, AK; Latitude: 62.0272° and Longitude: -158.2213°

Activity: Donlin Gold, LLC's application is classified under 18 AAC 50.306 to establish a new Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) gold mining and processing operation, 18 AAC 502(b)(3) for a rock crusher with a rated capacity over five tons per hour, and under 18 AAC 50.508(5) to avoid PSD review for SO₂ and to avoid HAPs major classification.

Emissions: The potential annual emissions of regulated air pollutants at the stationary source will not exceed: 1,589 tons of Nitrogen Oxides, 3,246 tons of Carbon Monoxide, 5,407 tons of Particulate Matter, 23.4 tons of Sulfur Dioxide, 1,148 tons of Volatile Organic Compounds, 1,742,900 tons of Carbon Dioxide Equivalent emissions, and 22.1 tons of Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP), with highest individual HAP formaldehyde estimated at 9.9 tons. The total annual potential emissions of regulated air pollutants, other than greenhouse gases, are 11,413 tons.

ADEC Preliminary Review: Based on review of the application, ADEC drafted a preliminary permit decision for this project under AS 46.14 and 18 AAC 50.
