









SITE HISTORY

- 1912-1920 Site was used as a tailings disposal site for mining activities
- 1982 Warehouse Building was constructed and operated as a mine assay laboratory, stored mining equipment

- 1982-2011 Ore House building was constructed and operated as a restaurant and event center
- 1998-2016 Warehouse purchased by AJT Mining Company, subleased to R&S Pumping Septic Company, and G3 Design
- 2017 Property Leased by Tlingit & Haida, Ore House was demolished via a controlled burn

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS



Soil Contamination

- Estimates between 250 to 470 CY of impacted soils remain on Site
- Excavation of soils may be necessary Groundwater Contamination
- ADEC requesting additional GW monitoring
 Underutilized Property
 - Possible demolition of Warehouse Building







- Discussion with Tlingit & Haida Business Economic Development division
- Eligibility for brownfields funding
- Possible removal of contaminated soil and warehouse
- Composting/Greenhouse/Culture Camp
