## NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS ON NUCLEAR FACILITY SITING IN THE REGULATIONS OF DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) proposes to adopt regulations to create a new chapter, 18 AAC XX of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with nuclear facility siting and microreactor location requirements, including adding sections to:

- (1) Describe the purpose of the chapter;
- (2) Describe pre-application and notice requirements for a nuclear facility siting permit applicant;
- (3) Set out application procedures for a nuclear facility siting permit;
- (4) Describe nuclear facility siting permit processing and issuance;
- (5) Describe nuclear facility siting permit modification, termination, and appeal;
- (6) Describe location requirements for a microreactor facility; and
- (7) Set out definitions for this chapter.

The questions must be received at least 10 days before the end of the public comment period. The ADEC will aggregate its response to substantially similar questions and make the questions and responses available on the Alaska Online Public Notice System and at <u>https://dec.alaska.gov/eh/</u>.
