Project #783251-GE, Lake and Monastery Sewer Improvements

ADEC awards \$810,000 low-interest loan to the City and Borough of Sitka for improvements to Lake and Monastery sewer

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) amended a previous loan to increase the total loan amount by \$810,000 to the City and Borough of Sitka. This project will include the replacement of approximately 2,500 linear feet of sewer main, 20 manholes, and 54 sewer services on Lake, Monastery, Kinkead, and Hirst Streets.

ADEC is authorized by state law to issue loans to borrowers for eligible water system infrastructure projects. Administration of the loan is through the ADEC State Revolving Fund Program under the authority of the Alaska Clean Water Fund.



The Alaska Clean Fund is capitalized annually by a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency. The Clean Water State Revolving Fund programs operate around the country to provide states and communities with the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure that protects our valuable water resources nationwide.
