A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
 CONSERVATION DIVISION OF AIR QUALITY’S MOTOR VEHICLE EMISSIONS BUDGET
 (MVEB) FOR INCLUSION IN THE STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

WHEREAS, The Fairbanks North Star Borough (Borough) has the highest recorded 24-hour levels of fine particulate matter (PM_{2.5}) in the nation; and

WHEREAS, A portion of the Borough was designated by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to be a nonattainment area for PM_{2.5} in 2009; and

WHEREAS, The Borough and the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (ADEC) continue to work as partners to bring the area into attainment; and

WHEREAS, ADEC developed and submitted a serious State Implementation Plan (SIP) in 2019 as required by the EPA; and

WHEREAS, The EPA disapproved portions of the 2019 SIP in late 2023 starting the sanction clock which among other things negatively impacts incoming federal highway dollars and local transportation construction planning; and

WHEREAS, ADEC is amending the 2019 SIP submission and providing supporting documents to attain full approval from the EPA avoiding further sanctions; and

WHEREAS, ADEC requests local support of the MVEB as included in the SIP amendment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Assembly of the Fairbanks North Star Borough supports the Motor Vehicle Emissions Budget for inclusion in the SIP amendment submittal for EPA approval.

CERTIFICATION OF ORAL HEARING

I, Cory McDonald, Environmental Program Specialist for the Department of Environmental Conservation, Division of Air Quality, under penalty of perjury, state the following:

On September 26, 2024, at 1200 – 1330 in the Exhibit Hall at Pioneer Park, 2300 Airport Way, Fairbanks, Alaska, and 1700 - 2000, in the Exhibit Hall at Pioneer Park, 2300 Airport Way, Fairbanks, Alaska, I presided over a public hearing held under AS 44.62.210 for the purpose of taking testimony in connection with the adoption of changes to Title 18, Chapter 50, Air Quality Control of the Alaska Administrative Code to:

Amend 18 AAC 50.030 to adopt revisions to the *State Air Quality Control Plan*. Those revisions include:

- a. revisions in Volume II, Section III.D.7: Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB) Fine Particulate Matter (PM_{2.5}) Serious State Implementation Plan (SIP) to:
 - i. amend Section III.D.7.06: Emission Inventory, by amending subsection III.D.7.6.1.1, and adding subsection III.D.7.6.9.
 - ii. amend Section III.D.7.07: Control Strategies, by adding subsection III.D.7.7.13.
 - iii. amend Section III.D.7.08: Modeling, by adding subsection III.D.7.8.15.
 - iv. repeal and readopt Section III.D.7.09: Attainment Demonstration – 2024.
 - v. repeal and readopt Section III.D.7.10: Reasonable Further Progress and Quantitative Milestones.
 - vi. repeal and replace Section III.D.7.11: Contingency Measures.
 - vii. amend Section III.D.7.12: Emergency Episode Plan, by amending subsection III.D.7.12.2, and Tables 7.12-1, 7.12-5, 7.12-6.
 - viii. amend Section III.7.14: Conformity and Motor Vehicle Emission Budget.
- b. amend Volume III Appendix to Volume II Section II to incorporate the proposed regulations after public review and comment. This appendix within the *State Air Quality Control Plan* contains the state’s air quality regulations.
- c. amend Volume III Appendix to Volume II, Sections III.D.06 – III.D.12 and III.D.14 to incorporate supporting documentation for proposed amended sections of the FNSB PM_{2.5} SIP listed above.
- d. write, public notice, and issue Air Quality Permits to incorporate the best available control technologies (BACT) emission limits listed in FNSB PM_{2.5} SIP Section 7.7.13.8.2.1 and the corresponding monitoring, recordkeeping, and reporting (MR&R) requirements listed in Volume III Appendix to Volume II, Section III.D.07 for the sources listed in FNSB PM_{2.5} SIP Sections 7.7.13.8.3 – 7.7.13.8.7. The issued permits are anticipated to be completed this fall and will be adopted as part of this amended SIP for submission to EPA for approval.
