I certify that I have the capability and intention to dry the purchased logs before use by EITHER mechanically drying, where the drying process has been inspected and approved by the department to ensure consistency and reliability; OR seasoning, splitting, and storing the wood covered for at least 9 months unless otherwise confirmed dry. [Check local ordinances for additional requirements.]
