<u>TIME/DATE OF SPILL:</u> The exact time of the June 6, 2006 spill is unknown. The spill was reported to ADEC on June 6, 2006 at 4:50 PM by State Troopers. The accident occurred between 3:00 PM and 3:30 PM.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 10:00 AM December 12, 2006

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report.

<u>TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED:</u> Service Oil & Gas estimates 580 gallons of unleaded gasoline was released. This is a corrected volume estimate from the volume reported on Sitrep 1 for this incident.

LOCATION: Mile 173 Richardson Highway near Meiers Lake

CAUSE OF SPILL: Single vehicle accident.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Service Oil & Gas Co. (subsidiary of Crowley Marine)

RESPONSE ACTION: Regularly scheduled inspections of the spill sites were performed throughout the summer and into fall. The booms that were placed in the marshy area, during the emergency response, to prevent oil from migrating into Meier's Lake, were visually inspected for sheen or free product. No oil was observed in these locations.

Absorbent material had been placed in locations known to be seeping fuel at the base of the road. While performing inspections, Service Oil & Gas employees would also recover product by squeezing the absorbents with ringers. The recovered fuel from the absorbents was collected in 55-gallon drums.

Prior to freeze-up, the absorbents and booms were removed from the area. A total of 190 gallons of gasoline was recovered.

SOURCE CONTROL: The remaining fuel in the tank compartments was pumped out and the truck has been removed from the spill site.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Marsh area by Meiers Lake. No sheen has been observed on Meiers Lake

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The site will be transferred from the ADEC Prevention and Emergency Response Program (PERP) to the Contaminated Sites Remediation Program (CSRP) for further long term monitoring and project management.

WEATHER: Partly cloudy, 12° F, winds are 17 mph out of the ESE.
