The U. S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management (BLM), and the United States Geological Survey (USGS) have received the Potentially Responsible Party Notice - Request for Response from ADEC dated September 27, 2004, concerning the Camp Lonely Landfill. Both agencies are in the process of gathering documents and factual information pertaining to your request. It appears that much of the information requested is not in the files of the Alaska offices. We are looking at additional sources inside and outside the agencies and outside of Alaska to fill these information gaps.

To ensure a thorough and comprehensive reply, we will need additional time to respond; therefore, we request that both the BLM and the USGS be granted an extension until the close of business December 15, 2004. This combined request is forwarded by the BLM with consent of the USGS.
