Dear Mr. Lowery:

It has been brought to our attention that the landfill used by DEWLine Station, POW-1, Lonely AK, which is located on CIRI (Cook Inlet Region, Inc.) property, will be closed by CIRI in the near future. Therefore, it will be necessary to develop another landfill for POW-1's use.

Per our interpretation of 18 AAC 60.020 (a)(3), incinerator facilities generating less than 200 pounds of waste per hour, do not need permits to establish landfills. POW-1 meets this criteria, so we do not feel a permit is required. Our purpose in writing you is to make sure that there are no other special requirements that need to be met.

The proposed site lies about 1/4 mile southwest of POW-1, along the road to the stations' water lake (see attached Plot Plan). The terrain is relatively level, about 6 feet above sea level, and there are no water bodies nearby.
