### SITUATION REPORT

**INCIDENT NAME:** Eielson Air Force Base A10 Jet Crash **SITREP#:** 1

**SPILL NUMBER:** Requested. **LEDGER CODE:** Not requested at this time.

<u>TIME/DATE OF SPILL:</u> The A10 was reported to have crashed at approximately 8:30 PM on February 25, 2004, shortly after it had taken off from Eielson Air Force Base in Fairbanks. Eielson Air Force Base reported the crash to the Fairbanks State Troopers at 8:50 PM.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 1:30 PM on February 26, 2004

**TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT:** As additional information becomes available.

**TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED:** The A10 jet was carrying about 1500 gallons of jet fuel, 10 pints of engine oil, and 6 gallons of hydraulic oil. It is unknown at this time what, if any, product remains at the site.

**LOCATION:** The A10 jet crashed in the Chena Flood Plain area in the Fairbanks North Star Borough.

**<u>CAUSE OF SPILL:</u>** The cause of the plane crash is currently being investigated by the US Air Force (USAF) from outside bases.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): US Air Force

**RESPONSE ACTION**: The Air Force is currently assessing the situation. ADEC staff will be notified when the scene is safe and secure. The pilot of the A10 jet was pronounced dead.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** None.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED:** Unknown at this time. There is a small tributary in the area which feeds into Moose Creek. The Air Force, as part of their assessment, is ensuring that no product has impacted any waterway.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:** ADEC staff will conduct a site visit to determine the response actions required. Access to the site may be available on Friday February 27, 2004.

**WEATHER:** Partly cloudy, light winds, temperatures 15-25 degrees Fahrenheit.
