SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: F/V JAVA W - Kodiak

SITREP #: 1 and final

SPILL NUMBER: 04249922101

LEDGER CODE: Not requested

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: The U.S. Coast Guard received notification at 8:20 PM on August 8, 2004, that F/V Java W, was taking on water and would possibly sink. ADEC was contacted at 9:24 PM on August 8, 2004 by the Alaska State Troopers of the incident, who received the report from USCG Marine Safety Office Anchorage.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 2:30 PM, August 9, 2004

TIME/DATE OF NEXT REPORT: This is the final report.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: The Coast Guard was informed by the vessel operator that there was approximately 200 gallons of #2 diesel fuel on board at the time of the incident. The amount of fuel lost as a result of the vessel sinking is unknown. An over-flight by Coast Guard personnel on August 9, 2004 did observe light sheens in the area of the sinking.

LOCATION: Uyak Bay, Kodiak at Latitude 57 44.04N, Longitude 153 57.51W.

CAUSE OF SPILL: The cause of the vessel taking on water and sinking is under investigation by the Coast Guard.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Mr. Troyer, operator of the vessel.

RESPONSE ACTION: The 2 personnel who were reported to be on the vessel at the time of the incident were safely rescued by other vessels in the vicinity. It was not reported to the Coast Guard if the operator was able to plug the fuel vents.

SOURCE CONTROL: None

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Marine waters of Uyak Bay. No oiled wildlife has been observed.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: ADEC will continue to work with the US Coast Guard Marine Safety Detachment Kodiak to monitor the situation, and assist in a response as needed.

WEATHER: Rain, with areas of fog, NE winds 15-30 MPH, Temperature 55-60 °F


