<u>TIME/DATE OF SPILL</u>: Approximately 2:00 PM on August 2, 2005. The spill was reported to ADEC by DuRette Construction on August 4, 2005 at 10:00 AM.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 2:00 PM, August 9, 2005.

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: As the situation warrants.

<u>TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED</u>: #2 Diesel Fuel, 2,200 gallons as estimated by DuRette Construction.

LOCATION: Along the road system of Roosevelt Harbor, Zarembo Island, 15 miles West-Southwest of Wrangell

<u>CAUSE OF SPILL</u>: A dump truck carrying a full fuel tank, flipped over and released diesel fuel from the top of the tank and onto the road and adjacent ground.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): DuRette Construction, Ward Cove, Alaska

RESPONSE ACTION: This spill was not reported to the State of Alaska until Thursday August 4, 2005. Since that time, DuRette Construction personnel and over the last few days, Carson Dorn Inc. personnel, now under contract to DuRette Construction, have been on scene placing sorbent materials and sorbent booms around the site to collect and contain the spill. To slow down or stop the seep of spilled product into Roosevelt Harbor an interceptor trench was installed by the contractor downgradant of the spill site to contain and be a collection point for the spilled product. That interceptor trench has been working very well for the last few days. The US Forest Service, the property manager, has representatives on scene, monitoring the cleanup activities. Additional equipment, including 2 oil/water separator systems and additional recovery tank capability are on a barge expected to arrive in Roosevelt Harbor Wednesday. Cleanup activities continue although seepage into the interceptor trench has slowed down.

500-600 feet of ADEC hard boom remains deployed around the mouth of Roosevelt Harbor. Sausage boom has been placed inside the hard boom along the shoreline. A rainbow sheen is reported inside of that boom.

SOURCE CONTROL: The dump truck and the fuel tank it was carrying have been up righted and transported from the site.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: There have been no reports of oiled wildlife. Resources affected have yet to be assessed.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: A clean up plan has been developed and submitted to DEC for approval. Plans are in place to remove the oil contaminated soils and temporarily store them, in a segregated lined area, at an existing contaminated soils site in Wrangell. Approximately 400 cubic yards of contaminated soils have been removed so far. DEC is requiring a plan for the ultimate treatment and disposal of the contaminated soils.

USCG, USFS, ADEC, and ADF&G continue to monitor the situation.

<u>WEATHER</u>: Currently High 60°s F, winds to 10 mph. Forecast: Sunny, with temps. Predicted to be in the high 70's with 10 to 15 mph for the next five days.
