SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: F/V Hustler

SITREP #: 1 and Final

SPILL NUMBER: 05249931601

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: The vessel reportedly sank at approximately 10:30 AM, November 12, 2005. ADEC was notified by the US Coast Guard (USCG) at 2:00 PM November 12, 2005.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 3:30 PM, November 14, 2005

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: The quantity of fuel released is unknown. The vessel operator reported to the Coast Guard (USCG) that the vessel was carrying 240 gallons of diesel fuel in unvented tanks and fifty 55-gallon drums on deck containing diesel fuel and gasoline.

LOCATION: Marmot Bay, Afognak Is. 58.04.727N; 152.09.781W

CAUSE OF SPILL: Vessel sinking. The cause of the sinking is being investigated by USCG.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): James Cole (Vessel Owner)

RESPONSE ACTION: USCG contacted Alaska Chadux Corporation to retrieve the 55-gallon drums with F/V Captain Kid and M/V Lazy Bay. Thirty one 55-gallon drums have been recovered. Due to water depth the vessel owner will not attempt to salvage the vessel.

SOURCE CONTROL: A local salvor has retrieved 31 of the fifty 55-gallon drums.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: The waters of Marmot Bay due to the sheen observed.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: USCG will continue to monitor the situation with over-flights. USCG will conduct an investigation into the cause of the vessel sinking.

WEATHER: Light rain with wind from the east at 20 mph. 39 ° Fahrenheit.
