#### SITUATION REPORT

**INCIDENT NAME**: T/V Seabulk Pride Grounding SITREP #: 3

**SPILL NUMBER**: 06239903301 **LEDGER CODE**: 14204860

<u>TIME/DATE OF GROUNDING</u>: The T/V Seabulk Pride went aground at 5:25 am on February 2, 2006. The Alaska State Trooper reported the grounding to ADEC at 6:20 am on February 2, 2006.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 4:00 pm, on February 2, 2006

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: 8:00 pm on February 2, 2006

TYPE/AMOUNT OF SPILL: Tesoro Alaska reported that approximately 75 gallons of petroleum product was spilled to water and an additional 125 gallons of product was spilled and contained on the vessel. The vessel was transferring both gasoline and Vacuum Tower Bottom Blend (VTBB) at the same time so the exact volume of each product has not been determined. Currently the T/V Seabulk Pride is reported to be grounded half a mile north of the Kenai Pipeline (KPL) dock in Nikiski. The Seabulk Pride is a 600 ft, double-hulled and double-bottomed oil tanker utilized by Tesoro Alaska Company to transport oil. At the time of the grounding, the tanker was carrying 3,987,942 gallons (94,951 barrels) of VTBB. VTBB is a residual oil product that is not processed at the Tesoro Refinery in Nikiski. VTBB has a thick consistency, similar to asphalt.

The Seabulk Pride is also carrying 224,532 gallons (5,346 barrels) of Bunker Oil, 47,670 gallons (1,135 barrels) of gasoline, 520,800 gallons (12,400 barrels) of Heavy Vacuum Gasoline Oil (HVGO) and 100,506 gallons (2,393 barrels) of Diesel Fuel 2.

**LOCATION**: The tanker is grounded a half mile north of the Nikiski KPL dock at position 60°41.46"; 151°24.191". Nikiski is located on the Kenai Peninsula, 9 miles north of the City of Kenai.

<u>CAUSE OF SPILL</u>: The tanker was moored at the KPL dock transferring cargo and was struck by an ice flow. The mooring lines parted causing the vessel to drift northward and go aground approximately a half mile North of the KPL dock.

#### POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Tesoro Alaska Company

**RESPONSE ACTION**: The Incident Management Team (IMT) has been activated and is in place at the Cook Inlet Spill Prevention and Response (CISPRI) Command Center. The U.S. Coast Guard and ADEC representatives are at CISPRI responding to the situation. The M/V Champion was able to get a tow line to the Seabulk Pride just after high tide this morning but was unable to pull the vessel free. Two additional tugs (Glacier Wind and Stellar Wind) have been mobilized from Anchorage and have arrived and are standing by to assist.

The tugs Sea Voyager and Bulwark have been mobilized with the response barge 450-3 from Valdez. ETA to Nikiski is approximately late afternoon on February 3, 2006. The response barge 141 is being mobilized out of Seldovia, Alaska and its ETA is this evening.

USCG and ADEC representatives conducted an overflight at 10:00 A.M. and found the vessel aground very close to shore. There were no sheens or fuel observed in the water in the vicinity of the vessel or KPL dock area during the overflight. The next overflight was schedule to depart at 3:30 P.M.

**SOURCE CONTROL**: All valves associated with the cargo transfer were closed.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED**: The waters and shores of Cook Inlet.

<u>FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: The IMT is in the process of completing the proper permits to support the response. A towing and lightering plan is also under development to help move the vessel to deeper water. ADEC is mobilizing additional staff to ramp up the IMT at CISPRI for a 24-hour operation. The crew of the Seabulk Pride will stay aboard the vessel to assist in anyway they can.

**WEATHER**: Mostly cloudy this afternoon with scattered snow showers. Highs zero to 10 above except in the teens south of Clam Gulch. Light winds except west wind 10 to 20 mph near Kachemak Bay becoming light in the afternoon.

Tonight the weather is expected to be partly cloudy, lows 5 to 15 below, winds light.

Friday's weather is expected to be mostly sunny, highs zero to 10 above, Northeast wind 5 to 15 mph.
