**SITUATION REPORT**

**INCIDENT NAME:** Fort Wainwright Hangar 6

**SITREP #:** 2 and Final

**SPILL NUMBER:** 06309918004

**LEDGER CODE:** Not requested

**TIME/DATE OF SPILL:** The spill date is unknown. The Fort Wainwright Department of Public Works was notified of the discovery of the spill at approximately 12:00 PM on June 29, 2006. The DEC Northern Area Response Team was notified on June 29, 2006 at approximately 2:30 PM.

**TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT:** 12:00 PM, April 30, 2007

**TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT:** This is the final report.

**TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED:** Unknown quantity of gasoline. Other spilled products have not yet been determined.

**LOCATION:** Hangar 6, Montgomery Road, Fort Wainwright, Fairbanks, Alaska

**CAUSE OF SPILL:** Unknown. It is suspected that this is contamination from an old spill.

**POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP):** Fort Wainwright, US Army

**RESPONSE ACTION:** Additional excavation at the site was terminated on June 30, 2006. No additional excavation has occurred at the site since that time. Plans are to eventually cap the area with pavement eliminating further exposure.

During the duration of the cleanup, contract workers excavated 575 cubic yards of contaminated soil from the site. This soil is currently stockpiled on site and awaiting shipment to OIT for treatment. The soil will be burned to remove the contamination and then returned to Ft. Wainwright to be used as garbage coverage at the landfill.

This case was transferred from ADEC's Prevention and Emergency Response Program (PERP) to the ADEC Contaminated Sites (CS) Program in Fairbanks, Alaska on September 13, 2006. ADEC CS staff are currently reviewing a draft copy of the site assessment report provided by the Army. Sampling of the site revealed moderate levels of Gasoline Range Organics (GRO). The U.S. Army Center for Health Promotion and Preventative Medicine conducted a risk analysis of the samples. This analysis is being reviewed by the State Department of Epidemiology. ADEC CS staff are also awaiting the final report from the State Department of Epidemiology for consideration of their review of the risk analysis.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** The area has been fenced and is covered by a 20'x80' piece of plastic. Montgomery Road has been reopened to the public and vehicle traffic.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED:** Soil/gravel near the Hangar 6 replacement project.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:** Fort Wainwright engineers are currently in the process of redesigning the lighting plans of the parking lot. The site will be eventually be overlaid with pavement.

**WEATHER:** Mostly cloudy, 59 degrees F with calm winds.
