Borough.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 4:00 PM April 15, 2008

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: 300 gallons of used oil.

LOCATION: South Cushman Road ¼ mile west of the landfill in Fairbanks.

CAUSE OF SPILL: Six drums were abandoned at the site off South Cushman Road that were repeatedly shot at releasing most of the drums contents onto the ground affecting about 2,700 square feet of ground surface.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Alaska Department of Natural Resources.

RESPONSE ACTION: The damaged drums were placed in overpack drums and removed from the site to a secure location where they will remain until analytical work is completed. A vacuum truck was used to collect free oil from the ground. The free oil pooled in a 2,700 square foot area contaminating both snow and soil. Contaminated soil will be excavated and removed from the site. Analytical samples will be collected from the used oil to determine if the used oil, contaminated water, and soil should be treated as a hazardous waste regulated by EPA RCRA regulations.

SOURCE CONTROL: The damaged drums and free oil have been removed from the site.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Snow and soil impacted by the used oil.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Collect samples of the used oil for analysis to determine if the used oil, contaminated water, and soil should be treated as a hazardous waste regulated by EPA RCRA regulations.

WEATHER: Cloudy and 18° F.
