INCIDENT NAME: Atqasuk NSB Power Plant Glycol Spill SITREP #: 1

<u>TIME/DATE OF SPILL</u>: The spill was discovered by the powerhouse operators and reported to ADEC at 09:30 AM on August 20, 2008. The North Slope Borough reported the incident to ADEC at 1:00 PM on August 21, 2008.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 3:30 PM on August 22, 2008

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: 3:00 PM on August 26, 2008

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): North Slope Borough (NSB)

<u>TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED</u>: The PRP estimated 1,500 gallons of Dowtherm* SR-1 Heat Transfer Fluid was released. Dowtherm* is composed of 95% Ethylene Glycol.

LOCATION: Village of Atqasuk, approximately 60 miles south of Barrow.

<u>CAUSE OF SPILL</u>: Leak from a flow line in the NSB power plant hydronic system. The cause and source of the leak is under investigation.

RESPONSE ACTION: North Slope Borough, Public Works requested the Water Treatment Plant operators in Atqausk to build interception dikes in the flow-pathway, pump and containerize surface affected water, and deploy absorbent pads on sheen. The community lagoon is located down-gradient from the spill location. An environmental consultant retained by the NSB, estimated to arrive this afternoon will collect source and treated water samples from the drinking water lagoon and community storage tanks, and perform a site assessment of the release. Design engineers are scheduled to arrive on August 26, 2008 to assess the flow lines.

ADEC personnel from the Drinking Water Division assessed potential ethylene glycol impact to the drinking water pump and treat lagoon. ADEC personnel determined that the ethylene glycol levels were well below the drinking water quality standards. Water samples shall be collected and sent to a laboratory for analysis to verify site conditions. Sample results will be available in approximately one-week.

SOURCE CONTROL: Source is not controlled; however, operators have identified a potential segment of the hydronic system where the leak is occurring.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Tundra vegetation and possibly the community drinking water source. No impacts to wildlife or the aquatic community has been reported.

<u>FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: Continue to investigate the cause and source of the spill. The environmental consultant hired by the PRP will conduct an environmental site assessment and develop a cleanup plan for ADEC review.

WEATHER: Cloudy, <10 mph winds, 40° F.
