INCIDENT NAME: Flint Hills Refinery Oily Water Line SITREP #: First and Final

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: Flint Hills Refinery reported the spill to ADEC at 10:15 AM November 23, 2009.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 4:00 PM November 24, 2009

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report

<u>TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED</u>: The product type was oily water containing less than one percent oil. The exact amount is unknown at this time but FHR estimates 3,020 gallons of oily water was spilled at the refinery.

LOCATION: Flint Hills Refinery, North Pole, Alaska

<u>CAUSE OF SPILL</u>: The rupture of a 6" oily water line. The cause of the spill is under investigation.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Flint Hills Resources (FHR)

RESPONSE ACTION: On November 23, 2009 a refinery operator was conducting routine line inspections when the spill was discovered. Upon investigation, it was discovered that a quantity of oily water had spilled from a split 6" oily water line to the gravel pad underneath the pipe rack.

The line was immediately shut in and the source was isolated. A Flint Hills Resources Spill Response Team consisting of a total of 16 spill response personnel responded to the spill. Responders deployed boom to stop the spread of the product and used vacuum trucks to recover the oily water from low lying depressions in the spill area. Flint Hills submitted and received approval for cleanup plans that employed warm water flushing tactics to remove residual product from course soils within the spill area. ADEC is reviewing FHR's sampling plan to assure ADEC regulatory cleanup levels are met.

SOURCE CONTROL: The 6" oily water line was shut in and the source isolated.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Gravel pad, vegetation, and soil.

<u>FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS</u>: ADEC has requested that the size of the area impacted be delineated and that a final volume of oily water spilled be calculated for the department using multiple methods. Cleanup confirmation soil sampling will be conducted upon completion of the cleanup.

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy, temp 5 degrees F.
