### SITUATION REPORT

#### **INCIDENT NAME**: Drill Site 6, Well 11, Mixed Product Spill

#### **SPILL NUMBER**: 09399935501

**<u>TIME/DATE OF SPILL</u>**: The spill was discovered at approximately 10:30 AM, December 21, 2009 by a BPXA operator making a routine check. BPXA notified ADEC at approximately 11:17 AM on December 21, 2009.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 3:00 PM on December 22, 2009

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: 3:00 PM on December 23, 2009

**<u>TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED</u>**: The spill resulted from a 6-inch three-phase well line carrying a mixture of crude oil, produced water, and natural gas. The amount spilled is currently unknown.

LOCATION: Drill Site 6, Well 11, Prudhoe Bay, North Slope, Alaska.

<u>CAUSE OF SPILL</u>: The cause of the spill is separation of the well's 6-inch 3-phase flow line. The reason for the separation is under investigation.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): BP Exploration Alaska, Inc. (BPXA)

**<u>RESPONSE ACTION</u>**: Approximately17,000 square feet of gravel pad has been affected. Thirty eight cubic yards of contaminated snow has been removed from the oiled area. Additional contaminated snow has been stockpiled on-site and is awaiting transport to the Grind and Inject Facility for disposal. Nine spill responders have started delineating the extent of contaminated tundra.

Currently, two ADEC Prevention and Emergency Response Program (PERP) responders are in Prudhoe Bay for this incident. Another ADEC responder is en route to the North Slope.

**<u>SOURCE CONTROL</u>**: The 3-phase line was automatically shut in by the well's safety shut-off valve.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED**: Snow-covered tundra, gravel pad, and reserve pit.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS**: Response workers will continue to delineate the extent of contaminated tundra. BPXA has submitted a clean-up work plan for ADEC review.

WEATHER: Clear, -4°F. Calm winds. Wednesday, mostly clear. Highs 5 above. Southeast winds to 10 mph.
