This letter is in response to your storm water plan received on 2/23/2022. Based on my review and in accordance with 18 AAC 72.600 Wastewater Disposal Regulations, the Department's storm water approval is granted. This storm water plan approval constitutes an authorization as specified under AS 46.03.100(a). Please keep me posted if any modifications to the subject plans are made.

This letter of approval does not imply the granting of additional authorizations, nor obligate any state, federal, or local government to grant any additional required authorizations.

DEC regulations provide that any person who disagrees with this decision may request an informal review by the Division Director in accordance with 18 AAC 15.185 or an adjudicatory hearing in accordance with 18 AAC 15.195 – 18 AAC 15.340. An informal review request must be delivered to the Director, Division of Water, 555 Cordova Street, Anchorage, AK 99501, within 20 days of the permit decision. An adjudicatory hearing request must be delivered to the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, PO Box 111800, Juneau, AK 99811-1800; Location: 410 Willoughby Avenue, Suite 303, Juneau within 30 days of the permit decision. If a hearing is not requested within 30 days, the right to appeal is waived.
