## **ANNUAL REPORT REQUIREMENTS**

Permittees can submit annual reports using the form provided on page 1 to the email address above in accordance with the following guidance. Permittees must first certify (sign) the report in accordance with the Signatory Requirements (see Part V.GENERAL REQUIREMENTS Subpart H) of the permit. Certified reports can then be scanned (in pdf format) and emailed no later than January 31<sup>st</sup> for the previous calendar year. Permittees can also submit complete annual report forms using the mailing address above postmarked no later than January 31<sup>st</sup> for the previous calendar year.

If the permittee elects to submit annual reports via email, the permittee must retain the legible originals of these documents and make them available to the Department upon request. Unsigned reports will not be accepted. The subject line on the email should include the following: Report Type (insert annual) for Facility Permit Number (insert permit number). The permittee may also be required to submit certified copies by mail to the mailing address specified above to fully comply with permit reporting requirements.
