Small-Size Suction Dredge General Permit (AKG375000)

Annual Report Requirements

An annual report is required only for the following small-size suction dredges: freshwater dredges greater than 18 hp; and marine dredges greater than 23 hp.

Due Date: no later than **January 31** for the previous calendar year

If discharge to a receiving water occurs, monitoring results shall be summarized each month and reported to DEC as part of the Annual Report (AR).

The Annual Report must include the following*:

1. Permittee name,
2. APDES authorization number,
3. Receiving water name,
4. The period of suction dredging,
5. Monthly summaries of any monitoring results,
6. Any visual violation occurrences along with the actions taken to come into compliance, and
7. Permittee signature.

If there is no mining activity during the year or no wastewater discharge to a receiving stream, the permittee shall notify DEC on the Annual Report form.
