


Kenai Watershed Forum “Implementing Kenai River Water Quality Monitoring”



FY02 Grant Award: \$45,000 Project Match: \$39,780



Description and Purpose: This project implements a significant portion of the *Framework for Water Quality Monitoring of the Kenai River*. This includes advancing the MOU for water quality monitoring among agencies; advancing a Watershed Restoration Action Strategy; and coordinating and conducting a collaborative agency monitoring effort.

Matching funds will come from Kenai Watershed Forum as in-kind and direct financial support for those items listed above and will also come from two additional components within our water quality monitoring program: Outreach and Education Efforts; Direct Citizen Involvement.
