


Type of Authorization:	Authorized for continuous discharge of graywater and the underway discharge of treated wastewater treated through a Hamworthy wastewater treatment system configuration as approved by the Department in the current Vessel Specific Sampling Plan.

Effluent Compliance Point:	Wastewater effluent sampling port(s) identified in the Department approved Vessel Specific Sampling Plan.
Special Conditions:	The <i>Pacific Princess</i> is authorized to discharge treated wastewater into Alaska marine waters while underway at speeds above 6 knots. The <i>Pacific Princess</i> is authorized to discharge treated graywater into Alaska marine waters continuously.
Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR)	The <i>Pacific Princess</i> must submit a DMR with effluent limits for the Hamworthy wastewater treatment system that is found at the back of the GP or available on the Department's website: (http://www.dec.state.ak.us/water/cruise_ships/gp/10gp.html) or on a similar form approved by the Department.
