

Commercial Passenger Vessel Registration with the State of Alaska in 2005

Large¹ and small² ships must register with the State of Alaska prior to entering waters of the state. Forty-seven cruise ships registered in 2005: 29 large ships, 13 small ships, and 5 ferries. Table 1 summarizes cruise ship registration for the past five years.
